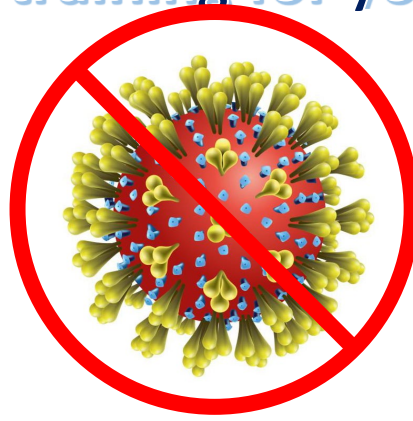


Infection Control training for your Business



Ensure your Workplace is equipped to manage the Pandemic! Get professionally trained in Infection Control

With the support of the Commonwealth and NSW Governments, TME is pleased to offer fully subsidised courses in cleaning to prevent infection.

The need to manage the risk of infection in the current environment is clear. No business can afford to unwittingly contribute to a virus outbreak due to lack of awareness or preparation of a safe and clean workplace, be it a general office, retail store, truck or delivery vehicle, or food preparation service. In fact, any business keen to train staff in the principles and practice of proper cleaning technique will benefit from this course, which will clearly form a key part of your COVID-Safe plan.

This initiative will enable business owners and employees to better respond to COVID-19 risks in the workplace and reduce transmission risk. It will also support customer confidence to re-engage with businesses.

Participants will learn a set of skills to follow organisational infection prevention and control policies and procedures, including implementing standard and transmission-based precautions and responding to infection risks in the workplace, and earn a Statement of Attainment to the relevant national unit of competency.

To suit your specific circumstances, various classes will be contextualised for the following *industry-specific skill sets*, in line with the directions of the Australian Industry and Skills Committee:

- **General Industry** (Infection Control Skill Set HLTSS00064)
- **Retail** (Infection Control Skill Set HLTSS00065)
- **Food Handling** (Infection control Skill Set HLTSS00066)
- **Transport and Logistic** (Infection control Skill Set HLTSS00067)

This is **either** a fully online, self-paced course (with trainer support available), **or** a 1 day face to face course, delivered by experienced trainers, which does require that participants spend some time in pre-course work, which is assessed. It includes practical demonstration of cleaning techniques for your particular situation, plus extensive knowledge of the source and prevention of virus transmission.
