Introduction

The VET student outcomes 2020 series provides a summary of the outcomes and satisfaction of students who completed nationally recognised vocational education and training (VET) delivered by registered training organisations (RTOs) in Australia during 2019, using data collected in 2020. This report is focused on qualification completers (previously known as graduates) who are defined as students who completed a training package qualification or an accredited qualification.

Highlights

Employment outcomes

Of qualification completers at The Management Edge Pty Ltd:

- 71% had an improved employment status after training
- 95.8% were employed before training. Of these, 2.2% were employed at a higher skill level after training.
- 4.2% were not employed before training.
- 85.8% were employed after training. Of these, 83.6% received at least one job-related benefit.

Students' satisfaction with training

Of qualification completers at The Management Edge Pty Ltd:

- 90.9% were satisfied with the overall quality of their training
- 88.8% would recommend their training provider.

About this report

Information in the report is presented on The Management Edge Pty Ltd qualification completers' reasons for training, their employment outcomes, further study outcomes and satisfaction with training. The figures are derived from the National Student Outcomes Survey, which is an annual survey of VET students.

Comparisons with the prior year are only shown where there are sufficient responses in the prior year. Where there is not a sufficient level of response for prior year comparisons, the 2019 data have been suppressed and the columns shaded in grey.
