What is the Chemical Handling Certificate short course program about?

The Management Edge (TME) in partnership are excited to announce a funded program delivered under the NSW Smart & Skilled program.

As a result of employer and industry feedback TME is conducting this program to assist employers, apprentices and jobseekers in learning the key skills of chemical application and transporting chemicals operation.

The aim of this course is to raise awareness of the potential hazards and risks associated with pesticide use and to provide practical information with regards to safe chemical handling and application. In addition this course introduces pesticide users to the principles of calibration. Participants will be expected to calibrate a piece of handheld equipment such as a knapsack, drench gun or injectable.
